Discussion continued on the need for beginner boats. Patricia requested that we sell the 2 Prijons, as they are difficult to adjust and consider purchasing 3 Australis

Platypus' as the one we have is quite popular. New prices for these are \$ 1090 without rudder, request Scotty to put in an easy to use slide rudder system rather than the system used by Australis - about \$200 per boat.

Decision: that the club sells the 2 Prijons, advertising within the club then on geartrade for between \$900 - \$750each then purchases 3 Platypus
